Terrain:

Hafnafjörður Miðbær: Competition area is located in the center of Hafnafjörður, where the streets are crooked and has lava terrain between(where the elves lives :).

Vífilsstaðahlíð: The area is located by the foot of a lava field. Fairly open terrain with dense forest areas in between. Hilly slope along the map. Öskjuhlíð: The third competition day is located around a small hill mostly covered by forest. Part of the area is with dense forest while other parts are more open. Small cliffs and rocks are common features.

Prizes:

The winner (over all three days) in each adult class (from 17+) will be awarded a prize at the event centre on the final day. For children classes will be prize for each day only in M14,W14, M12, W12. All children in M10 and W10 will get a medal.

SPORTident rental:

We do have a limited number of SPORTident sticks at our disposal (about 30 sticks) which can be rented.

It is preferred though that competitors bring their own SI-sticks or borrow from their own clubs.

Rent for SPORTident stick: €6,00 for the whole event For lost SI-stick €60 will be charged.

Training maps

You can buy training maps from our club, \in 7 for three maps of area in and around Reykjavík.

Accommodation:

Basic accommodation will be available at a local scout club house named Jötunheimar. There is room for **25-35 people** in five different rooms (5-7 in each room). There are mattresses in the rooms but no linen. A kitchen, toilets and free internet is available. Shower facilities are limited to one shower, but there is a swimming pool with hot tubs in walking distance. **Price per night is €12 for adult or children**

ICE-O dinner:

The dinner will be at the scout club (same location as the accommodation) at 19.00 Saturday evening.

Price is 28€ for adults and 16€ for children (6-16 years old). It is free for children und six yer old.

Transportation:

There will be arranged transportation to and from the event on Saturday and only to the event on Sunday. Total cost for the bus is 20 €. Further info will sent by email to all registered participants.
